From these nominations, our Law Enforcement Committee will select one individual as our Community Oriented Policing Officer of the Year, one for Police Officer of the Year, and one for the Valor Award.

## **The Awards:**

***Community Policing Officer of the Year Award*** – Awarded to a Broward County law enforcement officer for personal contributions to furthering community policing in his/her patrol area or city.

***Police Officer of the Year*** - Awarded to a Broward County law enforcement officer for outstanding performance in the line of duty, normally associated with a significant arrest of an individual or individuals who threaten the welfare of the community.

***Valor Award*** – This award is presented to a Broward County law enforcement officer who has exhibited extraordinary bravery and heroism relating to an imminent threat.

The chapter recognizes that all nominees are winners, and as such all the nominees will be considered for all categories and all nominees will be recognized at the banquet.
